Roll-off Disposal Requirements

If you have rented a roll-off for demolition purposes, please see the list of acceptable demolition materials below. If anything from the list of unacceptable demolition materials column is found in your roll-off by landfill personnel, your charges will be increased to the garbage rate, rather than the cheaper demolition rates. If you have any questions about what is acceptable, please call us to inquire.

Unacceptable Materials in any roll-off:

Tires, Florescent Light Bulbs, Pesticide Containers, Hazardous Materials, Liquid Cleaners, Asbestos, Slate Siding, Medical Waste, Oil Filters, Batteries, Carcasses, Electronics, TVs, VCRs, Computers, Monitors, Printers, Keyboards, Copiers, or any appliances.

Acceptable demolition materials:

Doors, Toilets, Insulation, Shingles, Windows, Tin, Plastic PVC Pipe, Siding, Wood, etc.

Unacceptable demolition materials:

Pop cans, caulk tubes, tires, garbage, food, carpeting, paint cans, tar pails, cardboard, plastic wrapping from insulation, paper wrapping from shingles, ashes or fire debris, treated wood, telephone poles, railroad ties, green treated wood.
